I refer to your email of 7 October 2021, to the Department of Corrections – Ara Poutama Aotearoa (Corrections), requesting the following information:

Total amount spent by Corrections on drug treatment and drug-related after care for those in prison and on community-based sentences, broken down by type of treatment programme if possible, for the years 2011-2020

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

On 5 November 2021, Corrections extended the timeframe of our response to your request in accordance with section 15A(1)(a) of the OIA. As noted in our letter dated 3 December 2021, the information had taken longer than we initially anticipated to prepare it for release. We reiterate our apologies for the delay in providing this final response to you.
