Proposal to Amend the Corrections Regulations

Portfolio Corrections

On 11 September 2019, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- agreed to remove tie-down beds as an authorised form of mechanical restraint in the Corrections Regulations;
- agreed to fix a previous amendment's inadvertent removal of a cross reference in the Corrections Regulations by providing Security Officers with the power to use handcuffs in conjunction with waist restraints;
- agreed to amend a requirement in the Corrections Regulations that prison search notices must be displayed informing people that they may be searched by 'detection dogs', rather than just 'narcotics detection dogs' as currently stipulated;
- 4 **agreed** to amend an erroneous cross reference in the Corrections Regulations that relates to the Chief Executive's decision to place someone in a male or female prison;
- agreed to update references in the Corrections Regulations that refer to the Legal Services Act 2000 to instead refer to the Legal Services Act 2011 which superseded it;
- **authorised** the Parliamentary Counsel Office to draft the amendments to the Corrections Regulations to give effect to these agreed policy decisions.
