Background

At 7.22am on 20 July 2023, Police received multiple emergency calls about a person shooting a gun on the third floor of a building that is currently under construction on lower Queen Street, Auckland. Three people have been confirmed dead with one of those being the gunman.

The gunman was Matu Tangi Matua Reid. Mr Reid was a 24-year-old man who was serving a sentence of five months Home Detention, with 10 standard conditions and five special conditions. Mr Reid's Home Detention sentence commenced on 28 March 2023 with an end date of 27 August 2023, and Post-Detention Conditions set to commence from 28 August 2023 through to 27 February 2024.

The Review

You will undertake a full operational review into the management of Matu Reid and his sentence and associated conditions.

The review will:

- 1 Review practice, processes, assessments and professional decision making in managing Mr Reid at pre-sentence stage and while on sentence in accordance with the Department's standards of practice.
- 2 Review the compliance of Mr Reid while on sentence and actions taken where non-compliance has occurred.

- 3 Review the Electronic Monitoring component of Mr Reid's sentence for compliance and response to any identified deviance in conditions.
- 4 Report on what can be learnt from this event, including any enhancements to management of cases regionally or nationally to improve and enhance public safety and intra / inter sectorial practice.
- 5 A draft of your review will be submitted to the Acting National Commissioner, Leigh Marsh, by no later than close of business on 11 August 2023.
