  - Importantly, the numbers in 'Appendix One' are not directly comparable to those reported in 'Appendix Two' as one perpetrator can have multiple victims, and vice-versa.
- Data provided is subject to change as incidents may be further investigated and reclassified. Accordingly, the information is not comparable to previously reported information.
