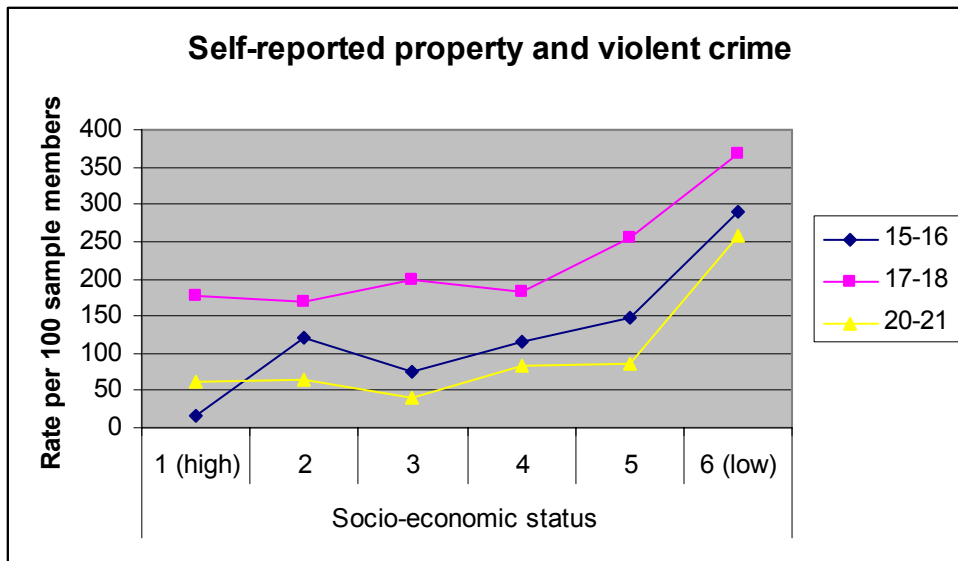

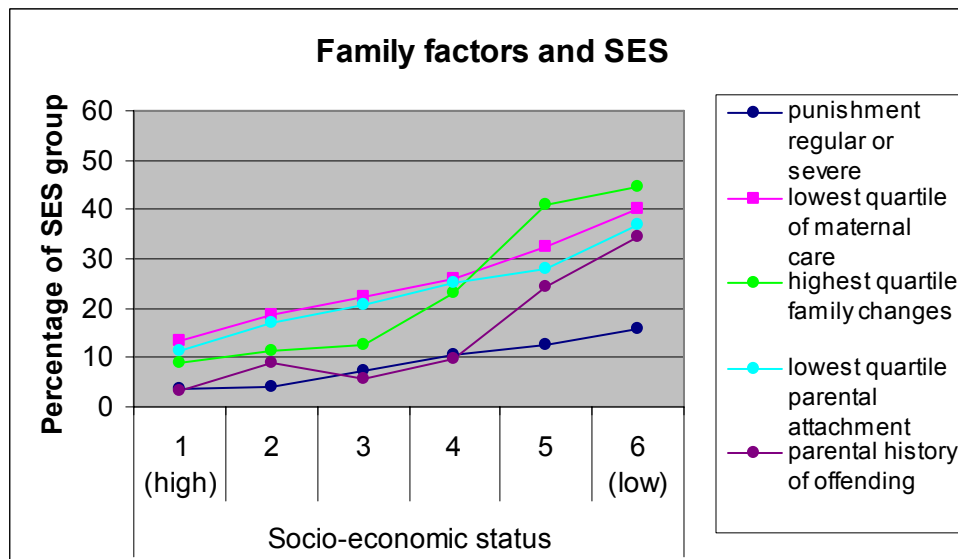
Figure 6.1: Self-reported offending and SES (rate per 100 sample members)

Figure 6.3: Individual characteristics and SES

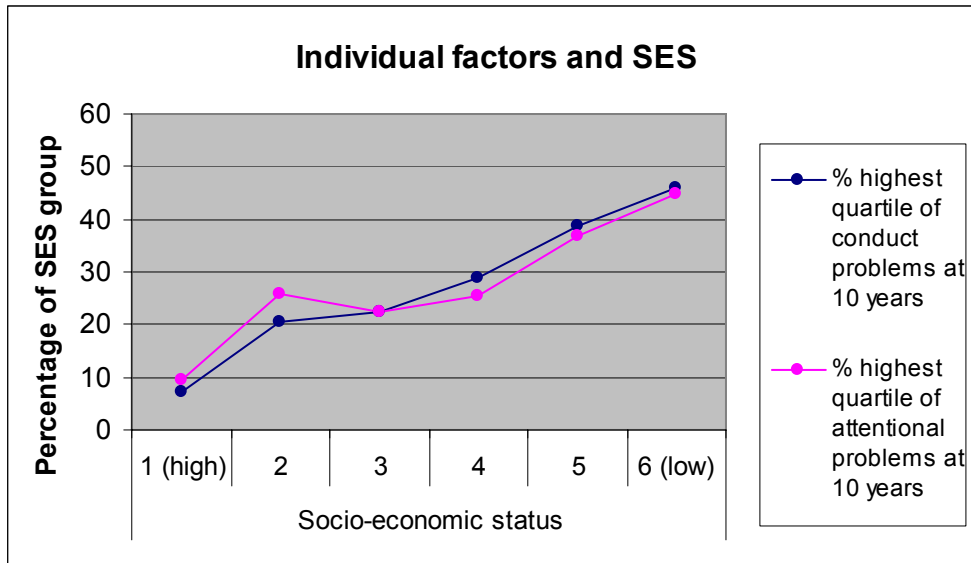
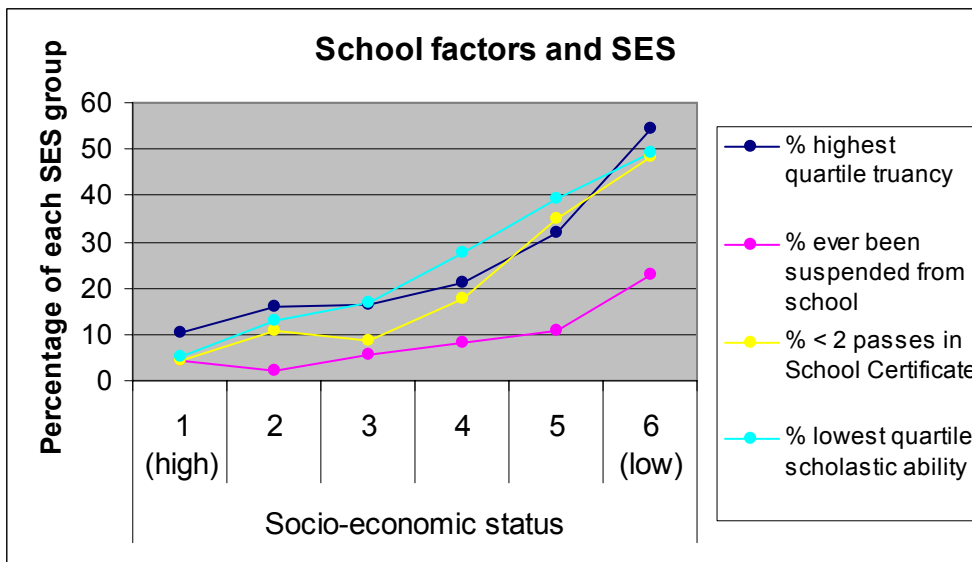
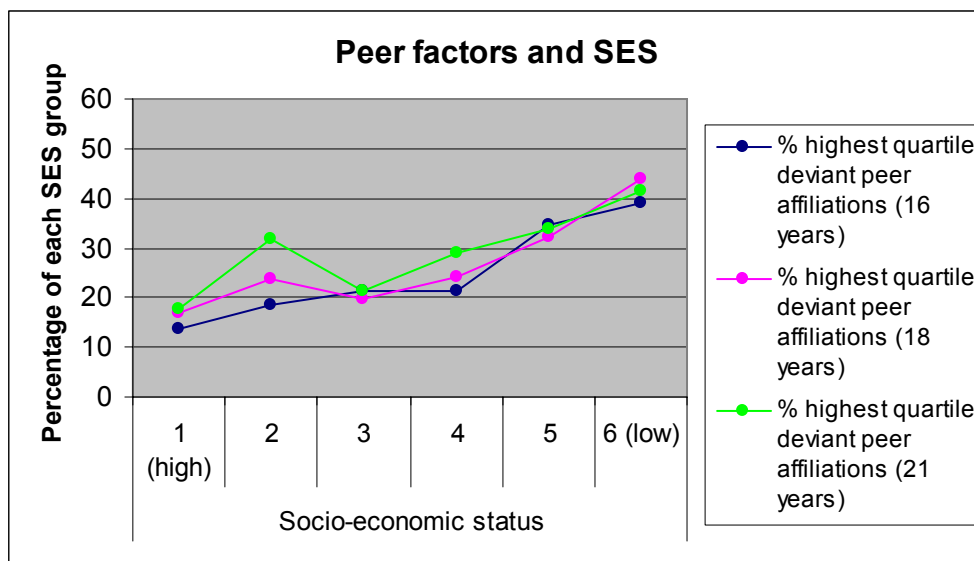


Figure 6.4: School engagement and achievement and SES
