The Next Step Towards a New Future for Ara Poutama Aotearoa

Portfolio Corrections

On 25 November 2019, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- noted that in December 2018, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee (SWC) agreed to adopt 'major improvement' in services as the strategic path for the prison network [SWC-18-MIN-0179];
- endorsed the Hōkai Nuku Change Programme, which describes a five year programme of change to deliver 'major improvement' to the corrections system, referred to above;
- noted that the Hōkai Nuku Change Programme is an essential step towards achieving the government's objectives of a 30 percent reduction in the prison population and eliminating the overrepresentation of Māori in the justice system;

- directed Ara Poutama Aotearoa to report on its progress towards major improvement by the end of 2020, and present SWC with options for the last three years of this change programme by the end of 2021.
